APPLICANT INFORMATION AND SELECTION GUIDELINES

The Summerville Rotary Club will present two \$2000 college scholarships to seniors at Summerville High School, Ashley Ridge High School, Pinewood Preparatory School, or who are sponsored by a Rotarian. As a guide to prospective applicants, the following are some of the areas that will be considered in awarding the scholarships:

Scholastic Standing – Your four year high school transcript will be reviewed for grade point average, SAT scores, class standing and college potential.

Extra-Curricular Activities – Weight is given to activities outside of the classroom such as membership in service clubs, varsity and intramural sports, band, student government and school projects. In addition, community involvement, church groups, scouting, etc. will be considered favorably.

Work Experience – Summer or part-time jobs, with hours worked and type of work should be put on your application.

Financial Need – What type of financial support will you be receiving from family, school or other scholarships and what do you believe your needs will be? Do you have any siblings in college?

Application Process- We fully realize this application form is somewhat limiting. Please feel free to attach additional sheets to expand on a given area. It is ***not*** required ***nor desired*** that you supply letters of recommendation from teachers or other individuals. Applications will be reviewed by your school counselor for completeness, the inclusion of a transcript and forwarded to the Rotary Selection Committee for screening. Several students will be asked to attend a personal interview where final selection will be made.
